SUMMER HAS ARRIVED!! A TIME TO REST AND ENJOY!!



SOUND SYSTEM UPGRADES & LIVE STREAMING

The last several weeks we have been upgrading the sound system in the worship space. The new digital mixers improves sound quality and control while also allowing for greater flexibility in choir and band set up for our celebrations. We are doing some final tweaking and it will take a bit of time to make it perfect for us. I want to thank Jeff Regan, our caretaker Herb Stockley and Dennis Cockerline for their hard work in making this all happen. It



The next step for us in the parish is to be able to live stream our Masses, celebrations and events on the internet. We already have an amazing website that allows us to be a constant presence on line. People have chosen to attend St. George because of seeing the amazing activities and events we have on the parish website. Nearly 100% of our summer camp registrations happen on line. We are certainly evangelizing the Good News in these modern times.



In order to be able to live stream and record our celebrations (to spread the Good News using modern technology) most effectively, there will be a need for a number of components. I have already acquired benefactors for a computer and television screen which will be used to control the live streaming in our Sound Room. A couple of parishioners have come forward to offer assistance. I want to thank them for

contacting me. We will still need to purchase the (1) appropriate video software, (2) a pan-tilt-zoom remote video camera, (3) an additional Go Pro camera (we will still use the one mounted above the baptismal font) and (4) cover costs for wiring and mounting hardware. I am not looking to do any type of campaign but if there is anyone who would like to get more information or would like to donate to this venture please contact me at the parish office. One of the ways for us to continue to reach out to the next generation and be present in our modern day is to make this step forward.




